Background

CDD in Partnership with CBM started its health and rehabilitation services for both Rohingyas and Host communities in Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh. The projects have two-pronged approach by prioritizing rehabilitation service provision and disability mainstreaming.

The focus here is on psychosocial services and the provision of rehabilitation services that includes physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech & language therapy, eye screening, hearing screening and provision of assistive devices as well as the strengthening referral services.

The mainstreaming activities are to promote the inclusion of people with disabilities along with strengthening the Age and Disability Working Group and the rights of persons with disabilities through formation and capacity building of Self-help groups (SHGs) and Disability Committees.

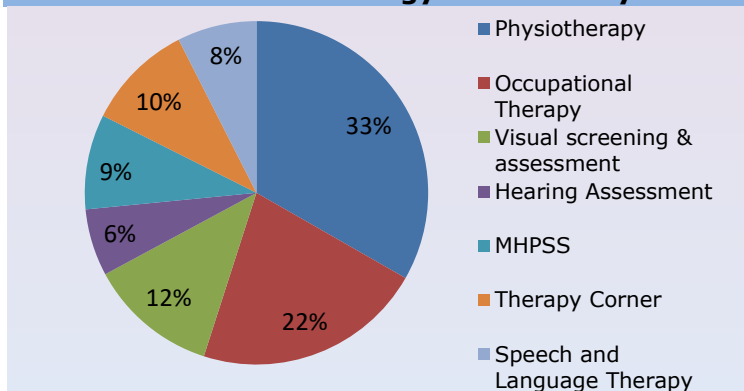

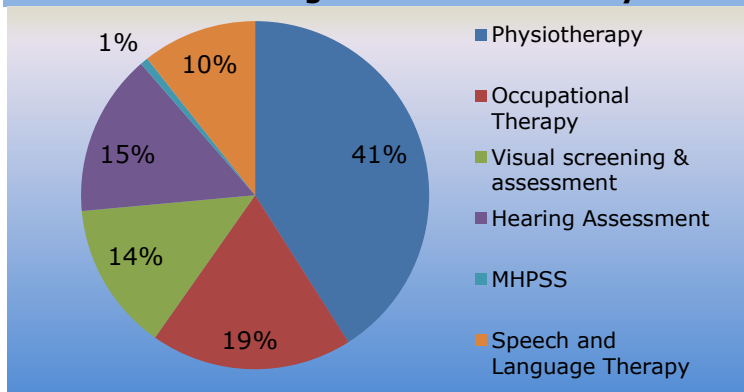
Rehabilitation services

During the month of January 2021, Four Home Based Rehabilitation (HBR) teams, all of our main camp staff & bus camp staff were on board along.

Service wise coverage at Host Community



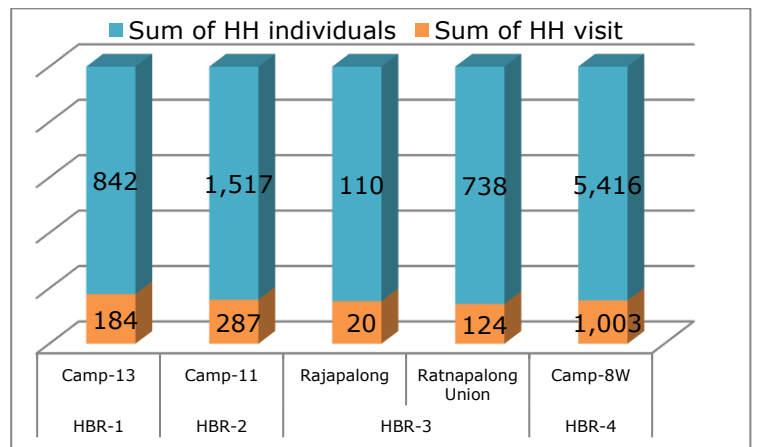
In January 2021, a total of 2,946 service sessions provided to the 788 beneficiaries with 49.02% male, and 50.98% female and persons with disabilities, almost 78.90% of total session. Within 788 clients, Physiotherapy 173, Occupational Therapy 78, Speech & Language Therapy 32, Visual Assessment 259, Hearing Assessment 204, Psychosocial Counseling 22 and referral 19.

During the reporting period, 57 caregivers trained up to care our beneficiaries where Female caregiver 44 and male caregiver are 13.

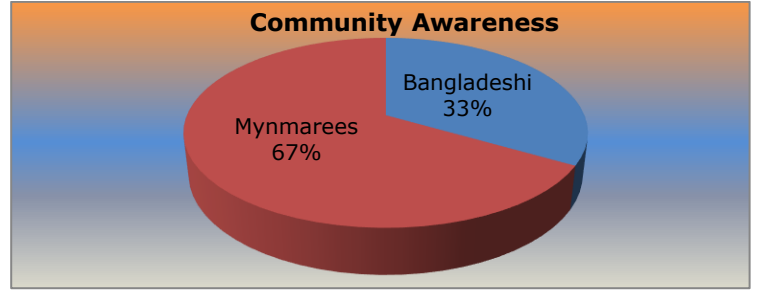

A total of 623 different assistive devices like Iron Ramp, Spike Ball, Bed Pan, Uring Pot, and Walking Stick have been provided among 587 (female 258, male 329) beneficiaries of Rohingya and the host community.
